- It is not allowed, without written permission from Dansmakers, to taking photographs, filming or making sound recordings.
- It is not allowed to bring chairs or stools from the foyer into the hall.
- There is no right to a refund of the price of a ticket once purchased.
- The cloakroom is unguarded; use is at your own risk. Please pay attention to your personal effects.
- Instructions from Dansmakers' staff must be followed.
- Please consider the neighbors across the Gedempt Hammer channel and leave as quietly as possible.
